Students accepted as freshmen (designated HSPT) are guaranteed entry into the professional DPT program pending successful completion of requirements. Students are required to designate their preferred track for the health sciences degree. For students admitted into the program as of Fall 2012 and beyond, academic performance will be reviewed at the end of the fall semester, sophomore year. In order to maintain status as a Health Sciences Physical Therapy (HSPT) major, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and earned grades of B or better in each required science course (BIO 101 & 102, CHE 211 & 263, PHY 151 & 152). A student may repeat no more than two science courses and any science course may be repeated only once. ACCELERATED TRACK Health Sciences (B.S.) – PT Track (HSP4: Guaranteed admission 4 years at undergraduate level; begin DPT program as graduate student subsequent semester) pending successful completion of requirements. Designation of selected track is required at start of freshman year, fall semester. Should a student find it necessary to change from the selected track, admission into the DPT program will not be guaranteed.
